Re: Signs By-law

This letter is to advise you that the report dealing with the details of the City Council approved Signs By-law Review Study, approved on December 6, 1989, will be considered as a replacement by-law by Planning Committee on November 27, 1990.

The study recommended the replacement of the current by-law and changes to the administrative process and enforcement. The study also involved an extensive review of the current regulations and a Public Participation Process which identified issues of concern with the existing by-law including methods of addressing them by means of new or modified provisions and administrative procedures. To implement the study recommendations and City Council objectives a replacement by-law has been prepared. However, for those areas of the by-law that were determined to require additional review, the by-law has been left essentially unchanged. Each of these issues will be addressed within separate reports by Planning Committee and City Council over the next 12 months, the results of which will become amendments to the new by-law. These issues include:

- Off-Premises Signs (billboards). 1.
- 2.
- Mobile Signs. Signs Within/Near Residential Zones. 3.
- 4. Message Centre/Time and Temperature Signs.
- Neon Sign Defined Special Signage Areas. 5.
- 6. Sign Review Committee.
- 7. Sign Encroachment Over City Property.
- 8. Sparks Street Mall Authority.

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The new by-law has been prepared in the above manner so as to facilitate the enactment of the new by-law, reflecting all aspects resolved through the study process, as expeditiously as possible. The remaining issues may then be addressed comprehensively without delaying the enactment of the new by-law. Notification of all subsequent issue reports, as listed above, will be circulated prior to Planning Committee consideration.
